2. Under the **Students and Parents** navigation tab, click on **Resources**

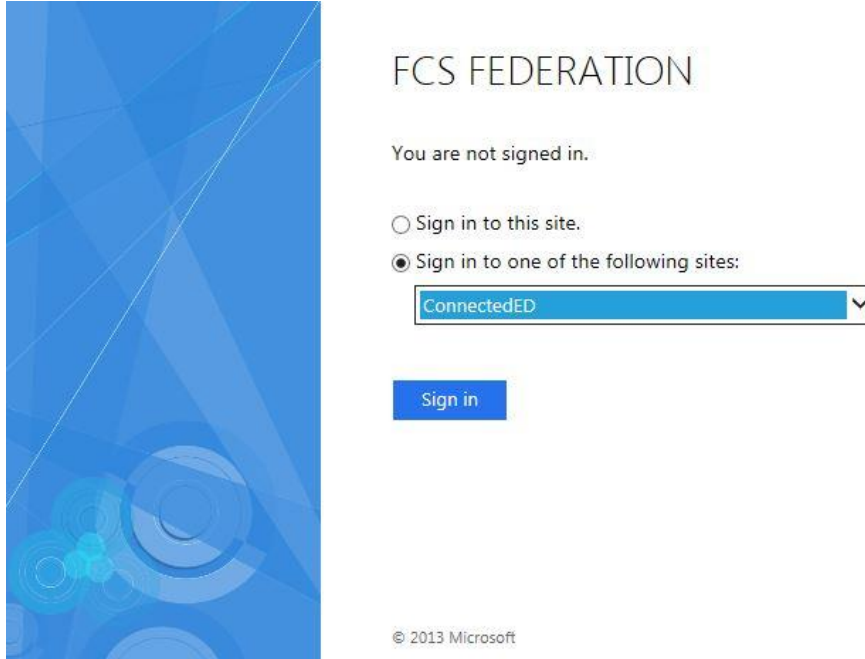
